

# BYCYCLE SAFETY



**A BYCYCLE IS A VEHICLE.** It should be operated in the road and the operator must follow the rules of the road:

– **Obey traffic signs.** Obey all traffic control devices including posted speed limits.

**Use hand signals.**

**Ride single file.**

**Ride on the right side of the road.**

**Be visible day and night.** Wear light colored clothes and or a reflective vest or belt. If you ride after dark you must have a headlight and reflectors.

**ALWAYS wear your helmet.** Your head is one valuable asset that cannot be replaced. NOTE: DODI 6055.4 require bike helmets on ALL bicycle riders on DOD installations
