

HOME MAINTENANCE SAFETY



DO NOT attempt a job you are not prepared or qualified to do. Leave it to the pros.

WHEN you start your job take your time, do it right, do it safe.

LAWN CARE IMPLEMENTS:

POWER MOWERS: wear shoes, steel toes preferred. Keep kids away. Check yard for debris, watch for flying objects.

WEEDEATERS: Long pants and eye protections

EDGERS: Extremely dangerous, flying objects and exposed blades. Keep children away.

HEDGE TRIMMERS: Good leather gloves and eye protection. Watch out for your electrical cord.

LADDERS: avoid standing on chairs. Make sure ladder is in good condition. Avoid using aluminum ladders around electrical equipment.

WEAR/USE PROTECTIVE EQUIPEMENT: eye, hearing, hand, and foot. Don't bypass "deadman" switches or other safety devices.
